

Migrants' attitudes in Germany and Greece

Project funded by the European Commission, EUMC Call for Tender 2003/02/03, Budget Line 3207

The aim of the project is to provide a reliable survey of the attitudes of migrants in Germany and Greece towards their host societies. To make data on racism and racial discrimination in the different member states of the EU comparable, the methodological approach already developed in Denmark, Finland and Sweden in the context of the same EUMC program, will be followed where possible.

As regards the questionnaire, the methodology will be the one developed in Denmark, Finland and Sweden. The original questionnaire, as developed by Lange (Lange, A. (1997), Immigrants on discrimination II. Ceifo: Stockholm), after translation in German, Greek and the languages of the selected categories, will be used in the German and Greek survey. Concerning the data collection however, both in Germany and Greece a different approach is inevitable. The findings will be presented by the EUMC.
