The round table is also the **7th National Coalition Meeting** of the ‘**National Integration and Evaluation Mechanism (NIEM)**’ Project.

The meeting’s subject is: **"The issue of refugees' access into the Greek educational system"**. The First Section will address the theoretical approach and the design of national policy for the refugees’ integration via education, while the Second Section will focus on the identification of positive and negative aspects in the procedure and in the content of refugees’ integration via education.
