

Peer mediation in schools

Development of teacher toolkit and pilot implementation with a student group

Project description

ANTIGONE, in collaboration with Heinrich Boll Foundation, plans and implements a pilot educational project on peer mediation aiming to promote peaceful conflict resolution in schools. With the completion of the pilot project in the school, a teacher toolkit on peer mediation will be published in printed and electronic form. The toolkit will include the evaluation results of the pilot project, the workshops curricula as well as general information on peer mediation as an alternative means of conflict resolution in schools.

Project objectives

- promotion of peer mediation as a practice improving peaceful communication between students
- prevention / elimination of incidents of conflict, violence and bullying in schools
- development of students' knowledge and skills to resolve conflicts peacefully
- development of active listening skills in interpersonal conflicts preventing more serious problems coming up

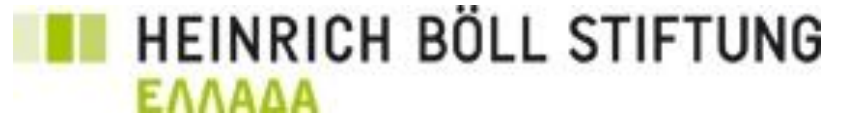
