Call for publications specialist for the project NIEM

From March 2017, ‘ANTIGONE – Information and Documentation Center on Racism, Ecology, Peace and Non Violence’ (ANTIGONE) is a partner of the European project “**National Integration Evaluation Mechanism**” (NIEM). NIEM is a six-year long transnational project which ends in June 2022, and aims to prepare key actors in the integration field in 15 EU Member States in order to better tackle current challenges and improve the integration outcomes of beneficiaries of international protection. Conflict situations tend to last longer and, currently, it takes on average 17 years before refugees fleeing war and conflict may have a chance to eventually return to their home country. Hence, the long-term integration of newly arrived beneficiaries of international protection is without alternative and presents an immediate challenge for European societies. The Project Leader is the Foundation Institute of Public Affairs (IPA) (Poland) and the funding is from the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund (AMIF) of the European Union.

ANTIGONE is looking for one (1) Publication specialist to support the NIEM Research activities.

Responsibilities include:

- Support, guidance, review of project publications (national research report & short briefs)

Required Qualifications

- BSc and MA degrees in Social Studies
- At least 3 years of experience in NGOs
- Proven oral and written skills in English

Desired Qualifications

- More years of relevant professional experience (10 points for every year, up to 4 extra years)

Other qualifications

- Strong communicational skills
- Capable of multi-tasking and well-organized
- Effective skills in working with colleagues at all levels
- Cultural sensitivity and demonstrated ability to work in changing environments

The contract will start in September 2021. The contract will be for 65 days and the daily rate is 140 Euros. Working hours will be decided and agreed upon conclusion of the contract. In case of any modification in the budget line, the contract will be modified accordingly.

In case the required qualifications are not met, the submitted offer will be excluded.

The points of the desirable qualifications will form the score of each candidate, which is the criterion for selection.

In case of equal score of the best two candidates, they will be asked to participate in an interview, where the other qualifications will be evaluated.
