Call for coordinator of research for the project NIEM

From March 2017, ‘ANTIGONE – Information and Documentation Center on Racism, Ecology, Peace and Non Violence’ (ANTIGONE) will be a partner of the European project “**National Integration Evaluation Mechanism**” (NIEM). NIEM is a six-year long transnational project which ends in September 2021, and aims to prepare key actors in the integration field in 15 EU Member States in order to better tackle current challenges and improve the integration outcomes of beneficiaries of international protection. Conflict situations tend to last longer and, currently, it takes on average 17 years before refugees fleeing war and conflict may have a chance to eventually return to their home country. Hence, the long-term integration of newly arrived beneficiaries of international protection is without alternative and presents an immediate challenge for European societies.

The Project Leader is the Foundation Institute of Public Affairs (IPA) (Poland) and the funding is from the European Union, Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund (AMIF).

ANTIGONE is looking for a (1) Research coordinator to support the NIEM Research activities.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to the participation in:

- Coordination and supervision of research activities (gathering & updating information, implementing & updating qualitative research and online surveys)
- Being responsible to liaising with researchers and experts from MPG, IPA and project partners
- Establishing contacts with relevant stakeholders
- Presenting research findings to high-level decision-makers, practitioners, media and the public
- Coordination of the preparation of reports based on the research findings
- Coordination and realization of national coalition meetings
- Ensuring the dissemination of research results

Required Qualifications

- BSc, MSc and/or PhD degree in Social Science, Political Science or Law or at least 10 years of relevant professional experience.
- Proven experience in the implementation or coordination of funded projects
- Proven oral and written skills in English (preferably Proficiency in English)

Desired Qualifications

- PhD degree accompanied with years of relevant professional experience (100 points for PhD, 10 points for every year up to 4 extra years)
- Proven oral and written skills in another European language (50 points for each extra language)

Other qualifications

- Strong communicational skills
- Capable of multi-tasking and well-organized
- Effective skills in working with colleagues at all levels
- Cultural sensitivity and demonstrated ability to work in changing environments

The contract will start from March 2017, and will be annually renewed until the end of the project, if all parties are satisfied by the collaboration. The contract will be for 100 days (annual basis) and the daily rate is 176 Euros. Working hours will be decided and agreed upon conclusion of the contract. In case of any modification in the budget line or project extension, the contract will be modified accordingly.

In case the required qualifications are not met, the submitted offer will be excluded.

The points of the desirable qualifications will form the score of each candidate, which is the criterion for selection.

In case of equal score of the best two candidates, they will be asked to participate in an interview, where the other qualifications will be evaluated.
