

## RENEWAL Southern Europe Regional Meeting

ANTIGONE participated in the Southern Europe Regional Meeting of the project “RENEWAL - Regional Networking for Adult Learning in Europe” and presented the best practices of ARTABILITY and SCHOOLS FOR CHANGE.

The RENEWAL meeting took place in Lisbon on 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> of October 2014.

The aim of this project, supported by the European Association for the Education of Adults (EACEA), is to strengthen the European Agenda for Adult Learning in the areas where the adult education sector is weakest (Southern and Central-Eastern Europe).

RENEWAL drafted a state-of-the-art report on the implementation of the Adult Learning Agenda, collecting info and data from adult education representatives and providers of the region, among which were ANTIGONE for Greece.

The survey results and reports were presented and discussed in the regional meeting in Lisbon.

Focus was also given to the exchange of good practices and network building among the different stakeholders in order to enhance the creativity and cooperation in this field.

ANTIGONE was invited to contribute to the meeting by presenting its experience in non-formal education for youth and educators, and its approach in the [ARTABILITY](#) project. As a Grundtvig Multilateral project, ARTABILITY focuses on adult education. The approach it uses is highly innovative as it aims to use art so as to reverse the mainstream educational concept that only considers people with disability as consumers and not producers of knowledge.
