**Activity Report 2019**

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During the year 2019, “ANTIGONE- Information and Documentation Centre on Racism, Ecology, Peace and Non-Violence” organised a wide range of activities:

- Prepared research reports for LEGALNET and FRA networks
- Coordinated and participated in projects financed by EU, international and national private foundations
- Organised multiple voluntary activities and events and participated in networks and various activities organised by other organisations
- Organised the 18<sup>th</sup> Round Table Against Discrimination in Athens

## **A. LEGALNET – European Network of legal experts on gender equality and non-discrimination**

LEGALNET is the European Network of Legal Experts on Gender Equality and Non-Discrimination, established in 2004 following an EU initiative implementing the Action Plan against racism. The activities of the programme include the specialised monitoring of all institutional developments on a legislative and jurisprudential level over the application of the principle of equal treatment amongst the EU Member States, in accordance with the Directives 43/2000 and 78/2000.

Since 2010, ANTIGONE has been chosen three consecutive times to participate on behalf of Greece in the aforementioned Network, carrying out annually a series of scientific studies following the request of the European Commission.

The deliverables of the year 2019 were the following:

1. Annual Report on the application of the non-discrimination Directives in Greece : basic text and summary
2. Flash Reports:
  - i. Abolition of age limit for the post graduate education of public employees
  - ii. Sanctions against private company for discrimination on ground of disability
  - iii. Abolition of time-limit from naturalisation for employment in public sector
  - iv. Confirmation by appeal court of a first instance court conviction of a doctor who had posted an anti-Semitic sign at the front door of his office
  - v. Sanctions against a private company for the dismissal of a HIV positive employee
3. Description of Ombudsman’ s Special Report 2018 on Equal Treatment, which was issued in 2019
4. Thematic Study: Questionnaire on Equality Bodies
5. Ad hoc requests:
  - i. Overview of national protection on grounds covered by the 2008 European Commission's proposal for an Equal Treatment Directive
  - ii. Information on Roma school segregation

## **B. FRANET**

In September 2018 “ANTIGONE” - with Center of European Constitutional Law (CECL) as a leader- was selected along with Hellenic League of Human Rights to participate in the FRANET project for the provision of data collection and research services on fundamental rights issues. The implementation of the Project started in January 2019.

FRANET is the Agency’s multidisciplinary research network. It is composed of contractors in each EU Member State who, upon request, provide relevant data to FRA on fundamental rights issues, to facilitate the Agency’s comparative analyses.

In 2019, in the framework of FRANET, ANTIGONE has worked with the Center for European Constitutional Law in order to implement the European Union Agency for Fundamental Rights's special program under the title "*Dangers to the Security of Pakistani Unaccompanied Minors in Greece*". The program lasted for 7 months (March 2019-September 2019). The overall purpose of the program was to evaluate the effectiveness of the protection mechanisms for minors applying to the unaccompanied Pakistani juvenile group, in accordance with the "principle of the best interest of the child", and to identify the areas that need improvement.

The program also aimed to identify good practices for the protection of unaccompanied children, especially those who have not applied for asylum and have not received international protection, including the security measures needed to prevent situations that may lead to exploitation or abuse. . "ANTIGONE" supported this research by voluntarily transcribing interviews, translating them from Greek into English and generally by contributing to the elaboration of the final texts.

An annual report for 2019 as well as quarterly newsletters with up-to-date institutional developments were also prepared.

### C.1 Projects in progress

**-National Integration Evaluation Mechanism ALL IN FOR INTEGRATION (NIEM):** NIEM is a European scientific program dedicated to the measurement, evaluation and monitoring of the integration of populations under international protection. The participating actors come from Greece, Poland, Belgium, Spain, Portugal, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, France, Hungary, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Netherlands, Romania, Slovenia and Sweden. The project is implemented in the framework of the programme run by the *European Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund AMIF* from April 2017 until September 2021.

**-Artability+:** This European project aims to empower people with disability through their participation in workshops in artistic techniques and art creation as well as through training on the organization of art exhibitions. Partners from Greece, Spain, Rumania and Lithuania collaborate for the design and implementation of educational material and workshops on art for people from different backgrounds and environments. The project is being realized under *Erasmus+ Program* from September 2019 until September 2022.

**-Reflective Expressive Artistic Learning (REAL):** Organizations from United Kingdom, Portugal, Poland, Lithuania and Greece collaborate in a project that explores the learning opportunities for young people with disabilities in the creative sector and reflect on inclusive practices raising aspirations of young disabled artists. Project includes learning teaching training events in each partner country as well as transnational meetings, learning events, online discussion and evaluation activities. This *Erasmus+ KA2* project started in July 2018 and is going to be completed in July 2020.

**-Words are stones:** The project aims at involving NGO activists and European citizens from Greece, Italy, Spain, France, Austria and Cyprus in stopping the present process of cultural, social, political and media legitimization of racism and xenophobia in the political and public debate. It includes research and dissemination activities, international meetings between youth activists, publication of reports and hand-books, video-clips, webpages etc. This *Europe for Citizens* project started in September 2018 and will end in February 2020.

**- Building Relationships and Integration by Developing local Groups and Enhancing Solidarity (BRIDGES):** Under BRIDGES project, 9 organizations from 5 Countries (Italy, Spain, Austria, Croatia and Greece) collaborate and interact with their local communities with the aim to strengthen the community as a whole, through the encouragement of dialogue

and mutual enrichment between third-country and host-country nationals. Project includes needs assessment of the selected local community, participatory community meetings, co-designing and co-developing of community activities, sports practices, cultural and educational events, voluntary activities for the implementation of community services, continuous communication activities of the project as well as video and online campaign, events, etc. This EU Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund project started in 2018 and will be completed in 2020.

- **Ta panta RE:** The project “Ta panta RE” aims at raising the awareness of the general population and the student community to the rational and sustainable management of household waste, trying to address the lack of information of the citizens of the Regional Unity of Thessaloniki on recycling, reuse, environmental protection and volunteering. Networking and dissemination, school information and awareness raising workshops for students, teachers and parents, collection and transportation of recyclable materials, information and sensitization of the local community apart the activities of the project that was launched in 2018 with a duration of 12 months. The funding of the project is on National Strategic Reference Framework, Operational Programme of the Region of Central Macedonia.

-**Public urban green spaces as the core for social innovation and civil society (In Social):** The project aims to the development, dissemination and exchange of best practices for the evaluation of urban green spaces and the promotion of their environmental and social benefits in order to link them to actions of social innovation and civil society activities. It includes the conduction of research, the development of evaluation methodology, the creation of an informative platform as well as the organization and implementation of educational workshops on innovative practices. *Europaid project* is being implemented by municipalities and organisations in Greece and Turkey. It begun in January 2019 and is going to be completed in January 2020.

-**Free your Hope (HOPE):** The main activity of the project is a coordinated and profound training of prisons’ personnel on preschool education methodologies and policies appropriate for children that live in prisons together with their detained mothers. It is conducted in Greece and Turkey including preparatory study visits, training sessions, activities in prisons, organization of a Conference as well as publication of relevant reports. The project is funded by *EuropeAid program*; it was launched in April 2019 and will be completed in July 2020.

-**Schools for change:** For the seventh school year, ANTIGONE with the support of the *Heinrich Boell Foundation in Greece* continues to collaborate with the school community (public education actors, school directors, teachers, parents and students) for the realisation of various non-formal education activities not only in the prefecture of Thessaloniki but also in

Greece in general. This year is the third school year that “Schools for change” project focuses on the promotion of peer mediation in the school community as a means of peaceful resolution of conflicts in school and in the group. In parallel, the project involves activities in various thematic units such as: human rights, xenophobia-racism, gender identity, hate speech, ecology and society etc. The entire educational activities of ANTIGONE aim to promote education for peace through awareness raising activities as a basis to reach democratic and participatory schools for all students without discrimination. The project involves educational programmes for students of every age, training sessions for teachers as well as experiential seminars for parents. The project started in 2012 and runs on school year basis.

## **C.2 Projects that their implementation was completed in 2019**

**-The route of solidarity: Citizens’ pathways towards and inclusive Europe (TROS):** Active volunteers and citizens from Greece, Spain, Italy and Croatia participated in a series of international meetings and web-actions with the aim to share their working experience with migrants and refugees. In parallel, a web-doc that followed the route of migration and solidarity in Europe has been developed. ANTIGONE coordinated the 4th TROS meeting in Lesvos, 23-29 of May, while the organization also hosted the 6th TROS meeting, in Thessaloniki, 17-23 of October. The project that started in October 2017 and was completed in March 2019 was funded by Education, Audiovisual and Culture Agency (EACEA) of the European Commission.

**-Managing Issues of Controversy by human Rights education (M.I.C.R.ON!):** Under the project ANTIGONE aimed to motivate and support the educational community to take action towards democratic citizenship and human rights education through the implementation of educational programs on handling controversy. Project included the translation and dissemination of the CoE educational toolkit “Managing Controversy” in Greek language, the implementation of a series of workshops for official education actors, school directors and teachers in 5 regions of Greece (Thessaloniki, Ioannina, Achaia, Heraklion and Lesvos) as well as the organization of an educational conference in Thessaloniki. The project was funded under *Democratic and Inclusive School Culture in Operation programme by the Council of Europe*; started in September 2018 and was completed in March 2019.

**-Cross the Borders:** This project supported the professional development of youth workers through the implementation of activities including transnational / international seminars, training courses, contact-making events, study visits and job observation periods in organizations active in the youth field. The partnership between Greece, Italy, Hungary and

Spain aimed to share best practices among youth workers in the field of youth migrants and empower social workers with abilities to better manage stress in work situation. The project run from April 2018 until June 2019 and was funded by *Erasmus+ KA1 programme*.

**-MED-looking Youth Shaping EU Policy for a “Ready Europe” (RE-YourEU):** The wider objective of the project has been to engage the participant countries (Italy, Spain, Greece) in anti-discrimination practices and migrants’ inclusion issues trying to develop and promote concrete and participatory approaches to “migration crisis”, a major EU problem, along with the “integration VS inclusion” challenges at local, national and transnational level. On the ground of promoting citizenship and common values of freedom, tolerance and non-discrimination through education, the project promoted the direct involvement and participation of young people in the policy shaping through a coherent structured dialogue process to ensure the effectiveness and comprehensive approach needed for making the most of the ideas and energies of future generations of European citizens. This *Erasmus+* project started in October 2017 and was completed in July 2019.

The training that took place in April 2019 in Rome aimed to the training and dissemination of Civil Courage methodology as a tool for the active defense and empowerment of migrant women who experience / have experienced hate speech. ### **Chromatodromos**

The members of the group are all artists with and without disability who meet every week at the premises of ANTIGONE that also supports the group with workshops and material. During the meetings, the group participates in a variety of activities that aim to the artistic expression and creation through various artistic methodologies and techniques.

### **Arts and Creative Activities for hospitalized children at Papageorgiou Hospital**

The organization with its team of volunteers run workshops for children on art and creation on a weekly basis at the hospital of Papageorgiou. The children who participate are all hospitalized at the Hospital's Pediatric Section. The activity took place during 2019 and keeps on the year 2020.

### **-Festivals, events, celebrations**

#### **“ReGeneration” Volunteer Program**

May – July 2019

Through the program titled “ReGeneration Volunteerism powered by ethelon” ANTIGONE welcomed and collaborated with young volunteers who had the opportunity to gain new skills and experiences. The group of volunteers were actively and creatively involved into various activities as for example the support of events and the actions of “Chromatodromos” cultural group that collaborates with ANTIGONE.

#### **Introductory training to “Color-Dance”**

Wednesday May 8<sup>th</sup>

Since 2012 ANTIGONE supports “Chromatodromos” group that runs on a voluntary basis and is formed by artists with and without disability. The group meets on a weekly basis and participates in workshops and artistic initiatives at the premises of ANTIGONE. Under this framework, the artistic group “Dryades” was invited to organize for “Cromatodromos” and

the volunteers of ANTIGONE a workshop on basic and supplementary colors through movement and rhythm.

**Forum for Integration “Je t’ aime,... moi non plus”: redefining the challenges of migration and integration in Greece and Europe**

Thursday May 9<sup>th</sup> – Saturday May 11<sup>th</sup>

Participation in the event that was organized by “Symviosis” NGO at the Municipality Hall of Thessaloniki. The event consisted an inter-scientific presentation of issues and problematic points on migration policy making, international protection and integration.

**Event “Solidarity economy and democracy”**

Sunday May 12<sup>th</sup>

Participation in the event that took place at the Museum of Ancient Agora. Politicians, representatives of civil society organisations and initiatives of social economy, active citizens and professionals working for NGOs discussed on the existing challenges, opportunities and problems met in the field of social and solidarity economy as well as on its contribution to the democratic society.

**Event “Cycle Economy and zero waste”**

Sunday June 2<sup>nd</sup>

Participation in the meeting where cycle economy, the role of the EU and the steps to be followed for societies to succeed simultaneous improvement of social and environmental prosperity.

**Networking Event: “After Europe goes to the polls: Where is the European Union headed?”**

Monday June 3<sup>rd</sup> – Tuesday June 4<sup>th</sup>

Participation in the meeting that took place at Berlin under the organization of Heinrich Boll Stiftung. The topics of the agenda discussed were the growth of far right and populism ideologies in many European states, the way this influences the European elections and public speech and how the incident can be successfully addressed by civil society.

**Parathinoupoli Child Festival**

Participation in the festival of the municipality of Kalamaria together with other NGOs of Thessaloniki active in education and culture. ANTIGONE organized workshops on equality for the students of the schools that visited the festival as well as open workshops on human rights during the afternoons of the event.

**Thessaloniki Pride 2019 “We are making history”**

Tuesday June 18<sup>th</sup> – Saturday June 22<sup>nd</sup>

As it happens every year, ANTIGONE supported and was actively present in the 8<sup>th</sup> Thessaloniki Pride contributing in the sensitization and awareness raising of local community on LGBT rights responding to homophobia racist discrimination.

**World Refugee Day “The many faces of refugee: an alternative route to the centre of Thessaloniki”**

Thursday June 20<sup>th</sup>

As a funding member of Select Respect Network, ANTIGONE participated in the organization of the World Refugee Day that took place in many spots of Thessaloniki's centre with discussions, participatory workshops, cultural walks and artistic activities that brought together activists, refugees and active citizens. The Monuments' and archeological areas' Office of the Ministry of Culture and Sports, the Historical Archive of Greek Refugees as well as the Association of the Citizens of Rotonda collaborated with the member organisations of the network for the organization of the event.

### **Three-day Training: "Experiential learning for groups that run projects on sustainability"**

Friday December 6<sup>th</sup> – Sunday December 8<sup>th</sup>

"Environmental Education Centre of Eleftherio Kordelio and Vertiskos", "Environmental Education Centre of Poroia" and ANTIGONE jointly organized the training at Poroia of Serres addressing teachers and educators that implement projects on environmental education, cultural and / or health education, members of environmental education centres, coordinators for sustainability and members of NGOs and collectives experienced on non-formal education. The participant group was trained based on the principles of NDI-Non Directive Intervention.

### **"FASI-Festival of Alternative Salonika's Initiatives"**

Thursday October 10<sup>th</sup>

Participation to the alternative and diversity festival that took place with the aim to bring Thessaloniki's youth together introducing them to the organisations and collectives of the city. The festival was organized by the NGO "United Societies of Balkans" in collaboration with 6 local organisations including ANTIGONE.

### **3<sup>rd</sup> Select Respect Network Festival: Diversity and the city**

Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> November – Sunday November 24<sup>th</sup>

Co-organisation of the third annual festival of "Select Respect" network by organisations of Thessaloniki including ANTIGONE. This year's festival on diversity and the city included a conference and closed workshops on social inclusion as well as a three-day documentary festival on the same topic.

### **International Volunteer Day**

Thursday December 5<sup>th</sup>

"Thess-DIKTIO" network of voluntary organisations of Thessaloniki co-organised a street celebration with many parallel awareness raising events. For the first year the network run a thematic walking tour on local NGOs' premises aiming for the participants to get to know their action and activities.

**ANTIGONE actively participated in both "Select respect" and "Thess-DIKTIO" local networks' events and meetings. Also, it has been a vivid member in all preparatory activities of "Anna Lindh" international network. The organization remaining an active and embedded part of this common effort of networking that develops during the years.**

### **-Workshops, speeches, meetings with other actors**

### **Workshop for Volunteers “Ethnology of conflicts”**

Wednesday June 19<sup>th</sup>

The workshop was conducted with the participation of ANTIGONE’s volunteers at the premises of the organization. Through theoretical examples and activities the group discussed on the reasons that cause ideological conflicts between societies as well as the methods and the practices through which such conflicts and disputes can peacefully be handled.

### **Experiential seminar: “Gender discrimination, a psychosocial and legal analysis on gender stereotypes and practical tools for their abolishment”**

Friday June 28<sup>th</sup>

ANTIGONE’s members and the participants’ group were trained on the psychosocial and legal dimension of gender identity and expression. The aim of the seminar also was the investment of knowledge gained in participants’ personal, working and social reality. The seminar was organized by Heinrich Boell Foundation of Greece.

### **Opening of DIOTIMA offices in Thessaloniki**

Thursday April 25<sup>th</sup>

The event was organized by DIOTIMA on the occasion of the opening of their new offices in Thessaloniki. The participants were civil society organisations and local actors. ANTIGONE is in collaboration with DIOTIMA from the time that the organization held its offices solely in Athens.

### **Conference: “Intercultural training as a means of social inclusion. Experience, best practices and future challenges”**

Friday September 20<sup>th</sup> – Saturday September 21<sup>st</sup>

ANTIGONE’s members participated in the conference that was organized by the Regional Directorate of Primary and Secondary Education of Central Macedonia jointly with the Municipality’s Centre for Social and Innovative Action.

### **Scientific Symposium: “Domestic violence, stalking and hate crime. National and international approaches”**

Wednesday September 18<sup>th</sup>

Representatives of ANTIGONE took part in the symposium that was organized by “VIA STOP: Institute for the Prevention and Combat of Violence and the Promotion of Gender Equality” in collaboration with the British Embassy, the Metropolitan Police-New Scotland Yard and the Department for the Confrontation of Racist Violence of Thessaloniki.

### **ANTIGONE’S Annual Report**

Recording incidents of racism, discrimination, xenophobia and research reports or best practices of the administration in 6 critical sectors, namely employment, legislation, education, racist violence and health.
